



## TEXAS GOLD RUSH ADVENTURE AND MUSIC FESTIVAL 2010 VENDOR INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

### **Vendor Information:**

The Texas Gold Rush Adventure and Moore Mining Music Festival will feature a large & diverse group of vendors for the inaugural festival. Including carnival rides and games, great local restaurants serving not-so-typical festival faire, and of course, there will be traditional festival food offerings. The various vendor villages throughout the site will also feature fine art, craft, and resale vendors. Official Festival Merchandise will be available at the festival general store located in several convenient locations. Water, soda, power drinks and alcoholic beverages will be available at the saloons & bar tents site wide.

### **What we are looking for in our vendors:**

- We are looking for vendors who represent the quality and uniqueness of Texas's creative community. We are seeking vendors in the following categories:

#### General:

- Entrée food.
- Snack, Dessert & Drink.
- Artisan / Craft / Resale.
- Midway, Faire, Activities, Games & Rides. (Contact us for more info).

#### Special vendors needed for the Gold Rush Adventure:

- Because of the nature of the Gold Rush adventure, we are seeking vendors to sell or rent metal detectors to assist **Adventure Participants** to find buried treasure in the adventure area. These vendors will be placed outside the music festival gates and near the adventure area. (Contact us for more info).

#### Old West Theme:

- The event will feature an old west / mining theme. Vendors are encouraged to partake in bringing the theme to your individual booth and products you sell. And encouraged to dress in period costume. This is not mandatory.

#### Other Features:

- Besides the Gold Rush Adventure for 1 million dollars, the event will feature over 30 bands on 3 stages, kid's area, motor-cross exhibitions, fireworks shows, and much more.

**Estimated Attendance:**

- 25,000-35,000 per day is estimated, but not guaranteed.

**Event Date**

- The inaugural Texas Gold Rush Adventure & Music Festival will be held **March 2010 - Friday 26th - Saturday 27th – Sunday 28th.**

**Required hours of operation-Midway:**

- Purchase of booth space is for all 3 days of the event. Fri-Sat-Sun.
- **Friday** 1:00pm-10:00pm
- **Saturday:** 10:00am to 10:00pm
- **Sunday:** 12:00pm to 10:00pm
- All Vendors must open before gates, and may not close early.

**Required hours of operation-Campground**

- **Thursday through Sunday:** 9:00am-12:00am

**Vendor Load-In/Out:**

- **Food Load-In:** Wednesday March 24, 2:00pm-6:00pm
- **Food Load-Out:** All vendors load-out on Monday March 29, beginning at 9:00am
- **Art/Craft Load-In:** Thursday March 25, 10:00am-3:00pm
- **Art/Craft Load-Out:** All vendors load-out on Monday March 29, beginning at 9:00am

**Load In/Out Notes:**

- Once accepted to vend the event, the vendor coordinator will be in touch to schedule your load-in.
- Vendors with more extensive operations may be asked to setup a day early.

**Vendors may apply to sell the following items:**

- **Food:** Entrée meals, snack and dessert items.
- **Drinks:** Smoothies, lemonade, coffee drinks & hot tea only.
- **Art/Craft & Resale items**

**Note:** All items for sale must be listed on your application, and approved in writing by EPS. All vendors are chosen by committee.

**Restrictions:**

The following is not permitted:

- Sales of Alcoholic Beverages are not permitted.
- Sales of water, iced tea, soda & power drinks are prohibited.
- No flashing lights, music, bullhorns or hawking to the crowd.
- Vendor may not dump any waste or liquids on the ground.

- No trailers of any kind will be allowed on site. There is no room behind space for a trailer of any kind. (Smokers are ok if approved in advance). Trailers will be allowed in the vendor parking area near your booth space.
- Sale of tobacco product or drug paraphernalia is strictly prohibited.
- No weapons or studded jewelry of any kind are allowed.
- No fireworks of any kind are allowed.

**We will provide:**

- For a uniform look/feel, Tents/Vendor signs are provided to all vendors.
- Water source to fill containers. This is potable water that is intended to be used for washing only. And may not be used for human consumption.
- Health permit. EPS acquires permits from the City of San Antonio for all food vendors.
- 1 20-amp plug for craft booths and 1 30-amp plug for food. Additional power may be purchased for an additional fee. Contact us for more info.
- Dumpster or compactor nearby for solid waste.
- All vendors will be listed on the TGR website as well as in the event program.

**Vendor is required to provide the following:**

Food Vendors:

- Liability Insurance\* in the amount of 1 Million Dollars.
- Must list; Event Production Services LLC, TGR Group, and Peer Group Consulting as *certificate holder* and as *additional insured*.
- Do not send this now. If you are accepted to vend with us, an EPS representative will be in touch.
- Texas Sales and Use Tax Permit are required by anyone wishing to vend the event.

Art Vendors:

- Must provide insurance or sign a waiver of liability.
- Texas Sales and Use Tax Permit are required by anyone wishing to vend the event.

General:

- Vendors must provide all other gear, lighting, tables, chairs, etc for their booth.

*\*Food vendors only.*

**Other requirements:**

- It is recommended that you use propane powered cooking/heating devices.\*
- Vendor must remove & dump all grease and gray water to an approved container on site.
- All vendors must abide by all San Antonio / Bexar County Health Codes. We will provide you with their guidelines.\*
- Vendors are required to use post consumer waste products/recyclable materials.
- Event is rain or shine. Booth fee is non-refundable.
- Space is very limited. We recommend that all vendors respond quickly to insure participation.

***Accepted vendors will receive more detailed list of Vendor Guidelines and Load-In/Out instructions.***
